## Our Community

Located in Northwest Oklahoma, Enid is home to more than 47,000 people, as well as Vance Air Force Base. In 2003, community voters approved a measure for more than \$27 million worth of technology, transportation and building improvements for schools. More than 2,500 residents and parents contribute time to schools through volunteer programs, Parent Teacher Associations and Booster Clubs .

Enid residents are fortunate to have Autry Technology Center and branches of Northwestern Oklahoma State University and Northern Oklahoma College. The availability of the schools lends itself to many partnerships, including dual credit for EHS students at NOC and a branch of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics at Autry.

## Our District

Enid Public Schools consists of one high school, three junior high schools and ten elementary schools, which are commonly referred to as "neighborhood" schools. The district also includes an adult education center and alternative school. The district, with an enrollment of 6,500 students, continues to have test scores that meet and exceed state and national averages. EPS has twice been named a Blue Ribbon District by Expansion Management Magazine and is a Kennedy Center Partners in Education District.
