**Driver's Education: Class is for one session only. To qualify for summer driver's education, a student must be at least 15 years of age and a secondary school student at the time of enrollment.

Remediation courses will be available for those students who need to retest in Algebra I and Biology I "End of Instruction" State Tests. Parents of these identified students will be contacted prior to needed summer remediation courses.

Classes meet from 8:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. while school is in session. 90% attendance is required in order to receive a passing grade and credit for the course. Each course offered is ½ unit of credit per session. Classes may be canceled due to insufficient student enrollment.

Tuition:

Tuition is \$155.00 per semester (4 weeks)
Tuition must be paid at the time of application.
On June 1, 2009 tuition is non-refundable.
Make checks payable to "Enid Public Schools."
If a class is canceled tuition is refunded.
Scholarship applications will be available in the office.
Scholarships applications will be due back by April 30, 2009.
